On today's date, Officer Frederick Wolf, dsn 3312, and I received a radio assignment to 6104 Page to meet the victim of a stolen auto. Additional information was provided that the victim's small child was asleep in the backseat at the time of theft.

Upon arriving, Officer Wolf and I were met by the caller who identified himself as victim Ferguson. Ferguson appeared extremely upset and began crying while stating "My son is gone, my son is gone" repeatedly. I asked Ferguson to try and calm down so that I could ask him what had happened.

After composing himself, Ferguson stated he was taking his son to Children's Hospital ER because he had been vomiting throughout the night and was unable to eat anything. Ferguson continued his son was severely handicapped and he often had to seek treatment at the hospital.

Ferguson continued that while on the way to the hospital he decided to stop at the payphone at Page and Skinker and call the hospital. Ferguson stated he forgot to call the ER before he left the house and wanted to make sure the doctor knew he was on his way. While talking on the phone he noticed his vehicle drive away east on Page and out of sight. Ferguson advised he never saw who entered his vehicle and could offer no information on the suspect.

Ferguson's son was asleep in the backseat when the vehicle was taken. Ferguson stated his son was wrapped in a blue and red blanket and would be hard to notice if he did not wake up and move. Ferguson added that his son was only wearing a diaper at this time.

Ferguson had left the vehicle unlocked and running while he was on the payphone.

A canvass of the area by all Seventh District units was initiated. Ferguson was in my vehicle during this canvass and I conveyed him to the NPD after approximately 30 minutes.

Lieutenant Larry Lee, dsn, 8054, in vehicle 3701 and Sergeant Jimmie Ousley, dsn, 7524, in vehicle 3712, responded.

Lieutenant Arthur Ruehl, dsn 8709, commander of the North Patrol Detective Bureau was contacted and advised of the situation.

Sergeant Donald Henderson, dsn 8393, of the Juvenile Division responded to the NPD and conveyed Ferguson to department headquarters.
